To be eligible for a nomination, songs must be completely original, which automatically eliminates sample rap songs. Despite these obstacles, hip-hop managed to score a few oscar wins. As a music consultant, Farrell was tasked with reinteresting music from the nominated paintings, as well as compiling some original music. 2014 Pharrell earned his first Oscar nomination for Happy by Man-2. The category also includes: Sam, but not alone (Sam, but not alone), Let's Go (Frozen), Moon Song (Her) and Ordinary Love (Mandela A Long Walk to Freedom). Happy also appeared on Pharrell's second solo album, G I R 2015 Common, and John Legend scored a nomination for best original song for Glory, their joint song from the film Selma. Hip-hop is a cultural movement similar to Art Deco and the Harlem Renaissance, and like these movements, it includes several elements. Most hip-hop historians talk about four elements of hip-hop: tagging (graffiti), b-boying (holiday dancing), emceria (MCing) and rap. One of the visual elements - graffiti - technically speaking - but at the time it wasn't part of hip-hop culture because hip-hop didn't exist. DJ and MCing (and possibly rapping) launched the hip-hop movement, with dancing and style following afterwards. If you look at the movement from the beginning to today, you will see that these elements have expanded in broader terms: Visual art, which includes graffiti, as well as other graphic arts and film Written and Oral Word, which includes MCing, rapping and performing poetry Physical movement that includes a variety of hip-hop dance style that includes clothing and other objects of fashion texts are not the only words of the hip-hop movement. Poetry has also found a home in hip-hop, in the form of a spoken word - the process of reciting original poetry or the work of another in front of a group or audience. It should be noted that poetry for performance is not limited to the sphere of hip-hop, but it constantly dials a step within the movement for many years.
